As a Jubileader, students will be assigned a Student Success Mentor, (Dr. Gaynell Juarez, GEAR UP Site Coordinator), that will guide them through our Life Preparatory Program. The Student Success Mentor will assist their students with developing the skills and character necessary to prepare them for post-secondary education and career opportunities. JubiLeaders mentors will motivate and educate their students to act with understanding and purpose by demonstrating the DDVs to their school and community as well as supporting them with meeting their high school graduation requirements, TSI preparation, qualifications for the dual credit program, college entrance exams, and participation in community service that will build a portfolio for college applications. Student Success Mentors will also prepare their students to speak to corporate executives in their junior and senior years about the Determined Destiny Values of Leadership, Character, and Excellence with the goal of receiving college scholarships and aid in the search for paid internships in their field of interest.

The Jubileaders students will help in the transition of our incoming military-connected students. They will:

- welcome them when they arrive on campus
- walk with them to class

- introduce them to the principals, counselors, front office staff, etc,

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Campus-Based Military Liaison

The Military Family Liaison (MFL) duties include:

- Serves as the point of contact and works collaboratively between military-connected students and their families and the campus.
- Maintains familiarity with enrollment processes, records transfer, existing community resources, and student support services.
- Ensures military-connected students are identified and properly coded through the Texas Student Data System Public Education Information Management System (TSDS PEIMS).
- Determines campus-based supports and services available to military-connected students based on their unique needs, including their high mobility.
- Assists in coordinating campus-based programs relevant to military-connected students.
- Attends professional development or training annually to learn and understand topics related to the transition of military connected students and their families.
- Integrate the military child into the campus.
- Communicates with principals, teachers, students and parents.
- Reports to the principals and the counselor on transitional issues for the parent or child.
